The narrow Iloilo Strait separates the island from Panay and the shallow Guimaras Strait separates it from Negros.


Guimaras is composed of 5 municipalities, further subdivided into 98 barangays. It includes Inampulugan, Guiwanon, Panobolon, Natunga, Nadulao and many minor surrounding islands.

The province of Guimaras has a total land area of 60,457 hectares. Only **3.075% or 1,859.0608** hectares from the total land area is classified for mining activities with approved mining rights.
